

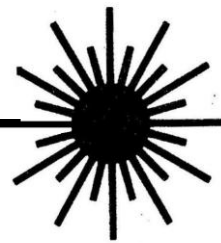

The Entry Fee is £147 payable by cheque to the UKLA (or credit card online), and to be received by 31st July 2010. The entry fee received after 31st July, but by 20th August 2010, will be £177. Entries received after 20th August will be £200. No entry fee is refundable after 31st July except at the sole discretion of the Organising Authority after the deduction of administration expenses of £15.00. Entries may be made on-line through the Event Calendar on the Laser website www.laser.org.uk

LIABILITY: By signing this form the owner/person in charge/crew accepts that he/she is responsible for him/herself and the above boat, including entire responsibility for his/her own safety, whether afloat or ashore, and nothing, whether in the Notice of Race or Sailing Instructions or anywhere else, reduces this responsibility. It is for the owner/person in charge/crew to decide whether he/she is fit to sail in the conditions in which he/she will find herself. By launching or going to sea, the owner/person in charge/crew confirms that **both their boat and** he/she is fit for those conditions and that he/she is competent to sail and compete in them. The owner/person in charge/crew is required to hold adequate insurance and in particular to hold insurance against third party claims in the sum of at least £2,000,000 for the duration of this event. Nothing done by the organisers can reduce the responsibility of the owner/person in charge/crew nor will it make the organisers responsible for any loss, damage, death or personal injury, however it may have occurred, as a result of the owner/person in charge/crew taking part in the racing. The organisers encompass everyone helping to run the race and the event, and include the Organising Authority, the race committee, the race officer, patrol boats and beachmasters. The provision of patrol boats does not relieve the owner/person in charge/crew of his/her responsibilities. The fact that the organisers conduct inspections of a boat does not reduce the responsibilities of the owner/person in charge/crew set out in this paragraph.

I agree to be bound by the Notice of Race, the Sailing Instructions, the ISAF Racing Rules of Sailing for 2009-2012 and the ICLA Rules. I am the owner/person in charge/crew of the above boat and I confirm that the owner/person in charge/crew holds adequate insurance and in particular holds insurance against third party claims in the sum of at least £2,000,000 for this event.
