

Laser Midlands Grand Prix Circuit after round 13

13 rounds have now been completed of the 18 event 2011 Laser Midland Grand Prix Circuit. The circuit kicked off in March at Chelmarsh in Shropshire with the latest round completed on July 17th at Rutland. This year has been blessed with decent wind, only Nantwich was a drifter. The turnout at these events has generally been good with 30+ boats at Rutland, Notts County and Ogston.

The current leader is previous winner Rich Bennett from South Staffs, Rich has won at Tamworth, Barnt Green and Burton and with three second places to make the six races to count Rich is going to be difficult to beat. His closest contender in second place is Craig Williamson from Staunton Harold with wins at Blithfield and Notts County. Meanwhile Paul Williamson from Staunton Harold is in third place and first Master with a single win at Hollowell. Other contenders are Rob Lennox from Barnt Green in 4th and Pete Newbery from Earlswood in 5th.

In the Radial fleet Rachael Lennox from Barnt Green has a narrow lead from Neil Marshall of Earlswood in 10th and 11th place respectively. Jessie Wellbourne from Ogston has made a late entry into the series but currently in 15th place could soon be in the running. Callum Lambourne from Swarkstone last year's 4.7 winner looks good again for 2011.

The next event on the circuit is Trimpley on 11th September.
