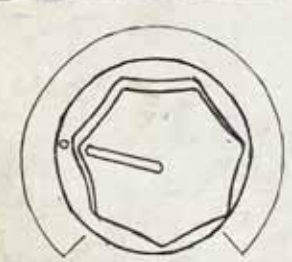

Laser 4.7 National Junior Squad
The Laser 4.7 National Junior Squad selection process is split into two phases. Phase One is selected in May and trains through the summer ideally until sailors graduate to the Laser Radial to focus on RYA Transition Training while Phase Two is usually selected in October and trains up until the RYA Youth National Championships at Easter.

Squad Places and Selection Policy

To be eligible for the Laser 4.7 National Junior Squad (summer phase) sailors shall normally be aged 16 years old on the 31st December in the selection year.

Introduction

Usually 12 Lasers 4.7 National Junior squad places are offered. It is aimed to award at least four of these places to girls. The first six places will be awarded to the top six sailors on the basis of the ranking list compiled from the two indicator events. The remaining Laser 4.7 National Junior Squad places will be offered to helms who have demonstrated the best prospects of progressing to the RYA National Youth Squads and the most potential to win medals for RYA Team GBR at future international competitions.
