RYA Volvo Youth Championships

Weymouth, Tuesday 6th April

Day 2 and another cracking day's racing. Both the Standard fleet and the Radials completed their scheduled three races.

The Standards did not race yesterday and so it was Races 1 – 3 that were sailed today. Alex Mills-Barton had the best start possible when he won the first race. However he was then called OCS in the next race and finally recovered to 4th in the final race of the day but until the discard kicks in, after 6 races, he is down the table overnight. Martin Evans & Eifion Mon are tied at the top of the leaderboard with a 3, 2, 1 & 2, 1, 3 scorelines. Phil Reynolds was also very consistent with all his results in the top FIVE.

The Radials are still in flights and sailed their second set of three races. Cameron Douglas counts five wins and a 2nd place, discarded, to head the fleet convincingly. There were also race wins for Bleddyn Mon, James Grant, Richard Keates, Elliott Hanson and Lorenzo Chiavarini. Sophie McKeeman has overtaken Rheanna Pavey as leading girl.

Three more races are scheduled for both fleets tomorrow and the weather forecast is not quite so nice.
