RYA Volvo Youth Championships

Strong Northwesterly breezes gave more intense racing to the Laser fleets. After six races Eifion Mon leads the Standard fleet having scored a very respectable 1, 2, 4 scoreline. Martin Evans lies 2nd overall a handful of points behind. Stuart Godwin & Alex Mills-Barton have now been able to discard their OCS results in the middle race on Monday and lie 3rd & 5th respectively, whilst Phil Reynolds is in 4th.

Today the 110 strong Radial fleet split into Gold & Silver starts. Both divisions completed three races each and every helm carried their nett score from the first six races into the finals. 'Earth', 'down' & 'bump' are all words that unfortunately might be in Cameron Douglas's overnight vocabulary. Having been virtually invincible for the first two days he showed a very fallible side today. Having won the first race he then fell away to record a 10th & 18th in the last two. This means he has been overtaken on the leaderboard by Bleddyn Mon who had a brilliant day with two 2nds and then the gun in the final race. In the Girl's fleet Rheanna Pavey is just ahead of Sophie McKeeman but it could go either way.

In the Silver Fleet Adam Underwood leads from Rhianna Massey and Alice Burford but the best performance of the day was by Andrew McGowan, who did himself a power of good with a 4, 1, 4 scoreline.
